Sub: Temporary approval of affiliation of Pacific School of Law,
Pacific Academy of Higher Education & Research University,
Debari, Udaipur for imparting three year LLB, five year
BA.LLB and five year B.Com. LLB law courses.

Sir,

Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 29th June, 2014 considered the inspection report of the above mentioned college. After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations:-

The Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report submitted by the inspection team. After consideration, the Committee is of the view that Pacific Academy of Higher Education & Research University Debari, Udaipur be recognized under Section 7 (1) (i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 for the purpose of conferring the degrees in three year LL.B course, five year BA LL.B course and five year B.Com LL.B course and also granted fresh approval of affiliation to its Pacific School of Law, Pacific Academy of Higher Education & Research University, Debari, Udaipur for running three year LL.B course, five year BA LL.B course and five year B.Com LL.B course with an intake of two sections of 60 students in each section in each branch for a period of three years i.e. for the academic year 2014-2015, 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 subject to the following conditions :-

1. The college management is directed to establish the Legal Aid Centre as per Clause-11, Schedule-III of Rule-11 of the Part-IV of the Legal Education Rules - 2008.
2. College should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
3. The institution is directed to upgrade the library by investing minimum Rs. 50,000/- per year per stream.
4. Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.

5. The institution is directed to purchase books at least of Rs. 3 lakhs for enriching the library as initial investment to be purchased within three months.
6. The institution should organize moot court competition of National level.

Institution should submit affidavit in compliance to the above conditions within three months.

Further, the Committee finds in the list of faculty members, one faculty is short for five year BA LL.B course. The college should appoint one more non-law subject teacher, that subject teacher not yet appointed, within a period of six weeks and intimate to the Bar Council of India through affidavit within the same period.

The above recommendations were considered by the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 29th June, 2014 and accepted the same.

The college shall also comply with the following Rule of the Bar Council of India (Clause (iii) and Explanation 2 of Schedule IV in Part IV of new rules of the Bar Council of India):-

"Whenever approval of affiliation is granted to the Centres of Legal Education, it shall be necessary for the Centres of Legal Education to deposit Rupees Two Lakh in shape of guarantee to fulfil all the norms of the Bar Council of India. The same shall be liable to be forfeited if norms are not complied with and same shall carry no interest."

The approval of affiliation now granted by the Bar Council of India is subject to the payment of guarantee amount as mentioned in the above rule.

College authorities are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval of affiliation six months in advance before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation granted by the Bar Council of India i.e. on or before 31st December, 2016 failing which a late fee will be charged.
